

**Element Sheet – Interference with Custody of a Child**  
**948.31(1)(b)**

1. At the time of the offense, the child had not attained the age of 18 years.
2. The custodian had legal custody of the child under a (court order) (judgment) in an action for divorce.
3. The defendant (caused the child to leave) (took the child away) (withheld the child for more than 12 hours beyond the court-approved period of physical placement or visitation period) from the custodian without the consent of the custodian.
4. The defendant took the child Intentionally.
5. The defendant knew that the custodian had legal custody of the child under a (court order) judgment) and knew that the custodian did not give consent to take away the child.
6. The defendant took away the child with intent to deprive the custodian of custody rights.
