

**Element Sheet – Receiving Stolen Property**  
**943.34 (1)(bf)**

1. The defendant intentionally (received) (concealed) the [property].
  - a. “To receive” means to acquire possession or control over the property.
  - b. “To conceal” means to hide the property or to do something else which prevents or makes more difficult the discovery of the property.
2. The [property] was stolen property.
  - a. Property is stolen property when it has intentionally been taken from the owner without consent and with the intent to deprive the owner of its possession permanently.
3. When the property was (received) (concealed), the defendant knew that it was stolen property.
4. *The presence of the following element (from sub. (1)(a)-(c)) increases the penalty for this offence from a misdemeanor to a felony: the value of the property was more than \$2,500.*
