

Element Sheet – Recklessly Endangering Safety (2nd Degree)
941.30(2)

1. The defendant endangered the safety of another human being.
2. The defendant endangered the safety of another by criminally reckless conduct.
 - a. “Criminally reckless conduct” means
 - i. the conduct created a risk of death or great bodily harm to another person; AND
 - ii. the risk of death or great bodily harm was unreasonable and substantial; AND
 - iii. the defendant was aware that (his)(her) conduct created the unreasonable and substantial risk of death or great bodily harm.
