

**Element Sheet – Robbery (Armed) by Use or Threat of Use of a Dangerous Weapon
943.32(2)**

1. [Victim] was the owner of property.
2. The defendant took and carried away property from the person or from the presence of [victim].
3. The defendant took the property with the intent to steal.
 - a. This requires that the defendant had the mental purpose to take and carry away property of another without consent, and that the defendant intended to deprive [victim] permanently of possession of the property. It requires that the defendant knew that the property belonged to another and knew that the person did not consent to the taking of the property.
4. The defendant acted forcibly.
 - a. “Forcibly” means that the defendant (used force against [victim] with the intent to overcome or prevent physical resistance or physical power of resistance to the taking or carrying away of the property) OR (threatened the imminent use of force against [victim] with the intent to compel [victim] to submit to the taking or carrying away of the property).
 - b. “Imminent” means “near at hand” or “on the point of happening”.
5. At the time of the taking or carrying away, the defendant used or threatened to use a dangerous weapon.
